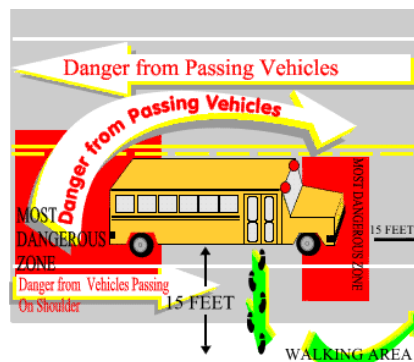




## Outside The Bus

### School Bus Safety Rules

1. Wear light colored clothing so the driver can easily see you.
2. Be at the bus stop 5 minutes early.
3. Line up early at the bus stop, no pushing or yelling.
4. Stay away from the curb or road until the bus comes to a complete stop, and the driver signals you to get on. Stay in your "Designated Place of Safety." Assigned by the driver.
5. If you need to cross the street wait until the driver gives you the signal that it is safe to cross. ALWAYS cross in front of the bus, NEVER behind the bus.
6. Stay out of the "Danger Zone." The "Danger Zone." Is the area ten feet around all sides of the bus.



7. If you drop something, NEVER go back near the bus to get it. Tell your driver and wait until you get the signal that all is safe.
8. When your bus comes to a Railroad Crossing, always maintain silence before and until the bus has safely crossed the tracks. The driver needs quiet to listen for any oncoming trains.
